Threat to Religious Liberty:

Bishops in Virginia are working through the Virginia Catholic Conference to affect public policy including the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services issued a mandate to require that almost all health plans include contraceptives, sterilizations, and abortion-inducing drugs. In the face of this unprecedented threat, the U.S. Catholic Bishops have called for Catholics throughout the country to become actively engaged in protecting religious liberty, our first freedom.

The Virginia Catholic Conference is the public policy advocacy organization representing Bishop Francis DiLorenzo, Diocese of Richmond, and Bishop Paul Loverde, Diocese of Arlington, on matters before the Virginia General Assembly, the U.S. Congress, and the state and federal administrations and their agencies.

Jeffrey F. Caruso, J.D., the founding Director of the Virginia Catholic Conference will address these topics in St. Patrick Parish Hall on Tuesday, May 22, at 7:30PM.
