

GENERAL THOMAS F. MEAGHER DIVISION SPOTSYLVANIA DIVISION NO. 1 AUGUST 2011 HIGHLIGHTS

Our new Division Chaplain, Father Ed Bresnahan, attended our August meeting (along with eleven brothers)! It is absolutely terrific that we have an active Chaplain. Special thanks to Father Bresnahan for his commitment to AOH!

We welcomed Brother Joe Daily, who is transferring from Father Kelley Division (Manassas). Brother Bob Errickson has completed his move to Sellersville, PA and will be transferring into Bucks County Division 2 (Doylestown). I spoke with Bob today (17 Aug) and he asked me to pass along his warm wishes and his heart-felt thank you to all division brothers for our prayers, generosity, and friendship.

Raffle Tickets update:

To be redundant -- we really need a full court press on ticket sales. We haven't broken the \$2000.00 mark yet, and we're obligated for a maximum pay-out of \$3400.00 to the winner. We only have one month remaining. I've mailed 24 raffle tickets to seven brothers who cannot attend regular meetings and asked them to return stubs, unsold tickets, and funds by Sept 1st. With minimum effort this may net 160 or more ticket sales!

After Mass Sales (we'll need volunteers at all Parishes!):

- o Father Zeigler, St Patrick Parish, approved our request to sell tickets after Masses on 17 & 18 September. We will advertise in the parish bulletin a week prior and Father will permit alter announcements at each Mass on 17/18 Sep.
- We'll also have opportunity to sell tickets at **St Jude**'s annual picnic on 18 September.
- o **St Mary** after Mass sales are 10 & 11 September.

For Golfers:

- The Division voted to sponsor a hole at the Jacob Michael Storck Charity Golf Tournament to be held September 30th at Cannon Ridge CC. Proceeds benefit Holy Cross Academy playground maintenance. For brothers who would like to make an independent TAX DEDUCTABLE donation see **Golfing4Jake.com**
- The Division probably will sponsor our own AOH golf tournament in March 2012 at Lake of the Woods CC. I ask brothers who enjoy connections with major vendors (Air Lingus, Guinness, Pepsi Cola, etc.) to contact them <u>now</u> for merchandise donations suitable for prizes and/or a raffle at the tourney.

Birthright: Last month I mentioned our high interest in how Birthright plans use our suggestions on revenue generation, overhead expense reduction, and a more efficient organization. Birthright responded on August 10th:

- First, On 1 November Birthright will move to new, less expensive office space (Paul's Bakery Office Park). *They are looking for help with the move during the last week of October.*
- Second, Birthright contacted the K of C Grand Knight and a mid-wife asking for board member recommendations. They will be soliciting others from different professions and hope to include a corporate financial executive, a lawyer, and a physician on the Board.
- Per Birthright USA Director, Birthright does not solicit contributions from pharmaceutical companies.
- Birthright is raising awareness through local Churches, their newsletter, notices in the bulletins, and a new fundraiser: selling discount cards for a special Macy's shopping Day.
- The note closed with a thank you for our suggestions and a hope that we'll become a "patron". Birthright considers AOH to be a friend.

New AOH Application Form: We received a revised AOH application (Form 41) that became effective July 7, 2011. The division discussed two elements of the revision:

<u>First</u> is the addition of "Irish by Adoption." Concern was expressed that National AOH is diluting membership requirements (no longer requiring "at least one drop of Irish blood") to mitigate dwindling membership. The sensing in Meagher Division is that

change as radical as this one should be brought to the floor of the 2012 National Convention for discussion and vote and not simply imposed on AOH in America.

<u>Second</u> is the addition of "Other Catholic Rites Recognized by the Pope." Father Bresnahan gave assurance that Rites recognized by the Pope should not be a concern. (I've identified 21 Rites recognized by the Pope.)
