February 2012 Highlights

Our monthly meeting convened as scheduled at 7:30PM, February 21, 2012. With prior notification, the vice president was excused. Eleven brothers attended.

Issues Discussed:

- The Annual Holy Cross Academy (HCA) St Patrick Dinner was discussed at length and in detail. We voted against hosting the dinner in 2012 for the following reasons:
 - Food safety ⁻ potential for illness caused by food preparation at private homes (some homes are up to one hour away from HCA), transported and re-heated util all we'd need is one sick kidu
 - Availability of pots at brothers homes large enough of prepare vegetables for an estimated 80 patrons.
 - The short two week notice believed unlikely ticket sales would be approved at other parishes or that parishioners from distant parishes would tackle rush hour traffic attend.
 - The conflicting schedules of CCW and PTO activities ¯ since those are the people who generally attend this event.
 - The pull-out of our co-sponsor, the PTO -- who did the preparation in prior years. TFM bankrolled the event and sold drinks and raffle tickets.
 - o The inability to identify alternative dates

- We voted to `lock-in_ our first annual **Halfway to St Patrick Day Party** for 15 September 2012, at the Lake of the Woods clubhouse. (The deposit check was delivered in 22 Feb).
- Letters to our four pastors were sent to update them on Division activities and charitable contributions during 2011 and to solicit support in fraternal year 2012.
- Participation in a *second* wreath laying at the Fredericksburg City Dock o/a December 13th each year. This ceremony is dedicated specifically to the Irish Brigade. After the ceremony re-enactors and others march along the historic attack route to the Marye Heights location where we now place a wreath each year. Meeting attendees thought we could do both ceremonies.
- Fraternal Year 2012 marks the **25th anniversary** of the General Meagher Division. I asked that we attempt to contact the 14 lapsed charter members to invite them to a planned dinner celebration to be held o/a November 27th.
- The "Vietnam Wall" in Ireland initiative s is now on hold at the request of my counterpart organization in Ireland who is experiencing financial challenges.
- Irish Heritage Day at the Nationals Ballpark is working from the Nat's perspective. However, the tri-state AOH board has not been forthcoming with indications of support and the time is fast approaching for 'fish or cut bait_ (teams already reported for Spring Training). In all probability this will <u>not</u> happen in 2012.
- I requested a past **Rose of Tralee** participate in our parade this year. The DC Area Rose Committee is working the issue.
- We voted to help defray the cost of sending division delegates to the **Biennial AOH National Convention** (9-12 July) in New York
