The Fredericksburg area Celtic band 'Aon_ agreed to play at the event for \$750.00 (Jeff suggested he might be able to negotiate a better priceǔ no word on that yet). I've received a quote of \$2.33each for pint glasses (to be given to each attendee) inscribed with the AOH logo and our division name. We need to identify an Irish Dance group to perform and ideally an Irish dance instructor to engage dinner guests. We should begin advertising this month in parish bulletins, on our web site and on the 'Aon_ web site, with the Knights of Columbus, local area Irish pubs and outlets, etc.
