Our Order's Shamrock and Major Degrees will be administered beginning at 11AM on Sunday, July 24th at the Koger Conference Center, 1021 Koger Center Blvd., Richmond, VA 23235-4756. General Meagher Division brothers who have not yet received one or both degrees are encouraged to take advantage of this rare opportunity to receive both degrees on the same day. These ceremonies will conclude our 18th Biennial State Convention. Although all active Brothers are welcome to attend the convention, convention attendance is not required to receive the degrees. I need to know who plans to attend!

Eleven brothers braved rain and storm to attend our May meeting last evening. One new brother, Desmond Flanigan, was initiated into our Order. Des is a St Patrick parishioner and Lake of the Woods resident. Approved for membership and awaiting initiation are Paul Chlebo, Roy Delaney, Dan Donovan, and Paul Simmons.

In a letter dated April 28th 2011, we received Diocese of Arlington permission for Father Ed Bresnahan (Parochial Vicar at St Mary of the Immaculate Conception) to become our Division Chaplain. I've sent Father Bresnahan the AOH Chaplain's Handbook and the State and National chaplain's contact information.

Both Holy Cross Academy and St Patrick School principals have selected students for the Division's scholastic stipend. The St Patrick school principal asked about the possibility of splitting our scholastic stipend between two equally qualified students. The Division voted not only to support this request, but to modestly increase the stipend for each student. I will send the students' parents congratulatory letters. The HCA student will attend Pope John Paul the Great High School and both St Patrick students will attend St Michael the Archangel High School. Checks will be sent to the high schools in the students' names to defray tuition and/or related expenses incurred by attending Catholic High School. Also, the Division voted to financially support Parish Work Camps. Donations will be made to St Patrick and St Mary. A donation will be offered to St William of York.

The Division reviewed the current charities committee charter and decided modification is not required. Key to this decision were the phrases "is it local" and ""does it advance Hibernian respect for life objectives." The charter does not specify "Catholic respect for life objectives." This interpretation and decision opens the opportunity for case-by-case donations to non-Catholic prolife charities. In this regard, a representative from Birthright will be invited to our June meeting. Subsequent to examination of Birthright's financial future, the division will consider a donation. The division also voted to reimburse expenses (NTE the cost of a "total package") incurred by our delegates to the VAAOH State Convention (21-24 July in Richmond). Meagher Division delegates are Gene McKenna and Bill Phillips.

St Patrick Golf Tournament: Lake of the Woods management offered us cosponsorship of a March 2112 golf tournament to honor of St Patrick, our patron saint. I await additional information wrt our obligations and responsibilities should we decide to do this.

Trip for Two Raffle Update: As of the May 2011Treasurer's report, we have not reached \$1,000 toward our lofty goal of \$8,000. This raffle is our only fund raiser. You've read of the Division's recent major charitable donations and those we've approved for the near future. To continue this community support, we really need every Brother's participation and to sell the 1,000 printed tickets. As of this writing we haven't sold 10%. Please recall our pledge to "be zealous for the interests of our organization."

"Irish Wall" Update: I've communicated with Mr. Lars Joye, the curator at Collins Barracks Museum in Dublin. I explained a vision of how the names of the 21 Irishmen and one Irish woman who died in Vietnam as members of the U.S. Military might be displayed in an 8"x12" area:

NAME Date / Place of Birth Killed in Action Date/Place Unit of Assignment This would mean an "Irish Wall" approximately 8'x8'. Mr. Joye advised that the museum is an Irish National Historic site and he'll discuss any modifications to the site with others associated with the museum.

General Interest Items:
