Committee Reports:

President Halpin sent letters to our member pastors (St. Patrick, St. Mary, St. Jude, and St. Matthew) explaining the program and soliciting support and publication of announcements in the parish bulletins. Father Ziegler (St. Patrick) and Father Rooney (St. Mary) offered space for our meetings: 7:00 p.m. on the first Tuesday of each month at St. Patrick and 8:00 p.m. on the third Wednesday of each month at St. Mary.
